<b>1</b>	Only one to rely on	Nebuchadnezzar's Golden Statue	First Commandment: No idols	To explain and expand on why idols are more than just statues, but things we rely on that are not God.
<b>2</b>	Right use of God's name	Balaam's ass (Num 22)	Second Commandment: Name in vain	To use the comedy of Balaam's Ass to relate what a proper use of God's name is: promoting mercy, grace, and justice.
<b>3</b>	Take a break and be still!	Resting in God (Ps 23)	Third Commandment: Sabbath	To create space to understand why God wants us to rest, and what that rest is for.
<b>4</b>	Seek wisdom, seek life	Value of Wisdom (Pr 2)	Fourth Commandment: Honor parents	To encourage honoring elders as a means of acquiring wisdom to love others and serve God.
<b>5</b>	Protecting life	Esther (Est 7)	Fifth Commandment: No killing	To show that "not killing" includes preserving and protecting the lives of others.
<b>6</b>	Sharing is caring	Lot's portion (Gen 13)	Sixth Commandment: No stealing	To explain how generosity is the flipside of greed and the best way to fulfill the commandment.
<b>7</b>	Till death do we part	David & Bathsheba (2 Sam 11)	Seventh Commandment: No adultery	To explain fidelity in relationships, whether romantic or otherwise, and how they reflect God's fidelity.
<b>8</b>	Assume goodness	Hananiah (Jer 8)	Eighth Commandment: No lying	To encourage seeing others' actions in the best possible light as a way to promote hope, love, and grace.
<b>9</b>	More than a theft	Naboth's vineyard (1 Kgs 21)	Ninth and Tenth Commandments: No coveting	To demonstrate that coveting is more than just wanting, but can lead to destruction.
