# **2021 Annual Meeting Minutes** February 20<sup>th</sup> 2022

#### **Minutes of 2021 Annual Meeting:**

Mike Allyn made a motion to accept the 2021 Annual meeting minutes. Lanette 2<sup>nd</sup>. MC

Report from Pastor Lucas: On file.

#### **Report from Treasurer:**

Beginning Balance as of January 1, 2021

General Account: \$8,131.71 Designated Acc: \$30,981.07 Money Market: \$74,903.02

#### **Ending Balance as of December 31, 2021**

General Account: \$79.80 Designated Acc: \$33,354.53 Money Market: \$74,008.36

Notes: We made a loan to our general account for \$4,500 to pay for pre-buy fuel. We are no longer taking money from the money market account to pay for Pastor's housing. The church is paying 100% of it. In May or June, we will find out how much Algot Anderson's estate will donate to the church.

#### **Report from the Audit Committee:**

Becky J and Audrey S found everything in order.

They ask the Council to discuss how long records should be saved and stored.

All reports and records will be stored in the record/fire room.

#### **Proposed Budget for 2022**

The proposed budget for 2022 is \$179,021.55.

This includes a 3% increase for Pastor Lucas and the Administrative Assistant position (Patricia). In June, the Council will look at how things are going and possibly propose another 3% increase to keep up with inflation. Notes: In 2021, we had a budget of \$1,500 for Church Repairs. In 2022, we proposed \$10,000. Some repairs will include sealing the parking lot, painting, fixing the concrete by the entry way. The sewer is not in the \$10,000.

A motion to accept the proposed budget was made by Rhoda F. Mike A. 2<sup>nd</sup>. MC

# **2021 Annual Meeting Minutes February 20th 2022**

#### **Endowment Committee Report & Dispersal of Funds:**

The Endowment Fund had an income of \$1,491.40.

The account balance as of 12/31/2021 was \$139,450.09. This included an incredibly generous gift from the estate of Algot Anderson. We are thankful and grateful for this lasting legacy that will generate additional interest income, and in turn increase the amount available for yearly disbursements. The donation was put in the savings account, but will be put in a fund to generate more interest.

Proposed disbursements for 2022 was \$1,500.

The Council proposed a Recognition Wall for those who donate to the Endowment Fund. Pictures for those who donate \$20,000 or more, and name plates for other donations.

A motion was made by Lanette to accept the report. Patricia 2<sup>nd</sup>. MC

#### Dispersal of Fair stand and Lutefisk Supper Funds:

The amount of disbursements is \$21,247.80.

This year was a record income for the Fair stand. \$2,500 of the Disaster Fund/ECON Assistance will go to the Ian Peterson family for their medical needs.

Mike A. made a motion to set aside one-half of OSLC Maintenance Reserved Funds, starting in 2023, to go to the Fair stand maintenance. After further discussion, Mike rescinded his motion.

Rhoda F made a motion to accept the Lutefisk Disbursements. Patricia 2<sup>nd</sup>. MC

#### **Nominating Committee:**

Thank you to all those who have served and are serving on a committee. We appreciate your time and talents. A recommendation was made to have the Lutefisk Supper go from co-chairs to a committee, since it is a big undertaking.

#### **Election of Officers and Committee Members:**

Vacancies filled at the annual meeting: The delegates for the Synod Convention on April 30, will be Donald Rosenberry III and Jill Rosenberry. Rhoda Foley will be on the Auditing Committee.

#### Pastor's Annual Report for 2022

Dear siblings in Christ,

We've come through a year with a lot to celebrate. Our congregation has engaged in its ministry with as much vitality, hope, and enthusiasm as the days before the pandemic—maybe even more! We've connected with our neighbors through our ballfield ministry, the fair stand, the backpack program, God's Work Our Hands, and countless other ways that remind our community that Our Savior's is a church which hears God's words of grace, hope, and love, and *acts* on those words.

In particular, I celebrate the ways that what God is doing here with us has attracted more people to join our work together. That was symbolized by the baptismal celebration we held in the spring, when five people were all baptized on the same Sunday! In the waters of baptism God calls us to share grace with our neighbor, and the joy of the baptismal waters permeated every part of our ministry together this year. Our newest members jumped in with both feet to participate in God's ministry in this place, and we are seeing the fruits of that enthusiastic work as our congregation's ministries thrive. It fills me with joy and brings me hope to see how full of life we are.

And this is especially true coming out of the shadow of the pandemic! Perhaps it's perfectly symbolic, then, that we made the move at the start of Holy Week to begin receiving communion at the front again. It feels like the momentum of God calling us together, physically moving us toward the body and blood of Jesus, has carried us through the year. We have seen our worship enhanced as the choir began singing together again. We saw new directions for faith formation in a cross-generational learning experience with Deacon Laura Ramlow. We engaged again with all the wonderful ministries we support in our community, not letting up on our generosity and energy to be God's people and serve others in God's name here where we are.

I am hopeful that enthusiasm will carry us through the next year, too. With all this energy and hopefulness that we are doing wonderful things in God's name, we will be focusing our energy in three areas: inward (improving our bonds inside the congregation), outward (connecting with ministries outside our congregation), and upward (connecting more deeply to God). We'll do that in the following ways:

First, our inward goal will be to have each committee produce and host different small projects that will give the congregation multiple opportunities to come together and do God's work while deepening their bonds of friendship with each other. These projects may be big or small; they might be about doing things with our hands or engaging our minds; they could be ten minutes after worship or two hours on a Saturday morning. Whatever they look like, there will be something that everyone can feel called to join!

Second, our outward goal will be to join with our fellow congregations in different ministries in our area. This could look like joint worship services, collective projects, mission trips, or bible studies. When we connect with our neighboring congregations, we strengthen God's mission in our area.

And finally, our upward goal will be to share God sightings. You are each invited to keep an eye open to name where you see God at work in the world—in big ways and small ways! When you have a God sighting, whatever it might be, share it on Facebook, or with the church office, or with a committee you are part of. We will regularly lift up and celebrate these God sightings as a congregation, and by the end of the year will be able to reflect on the amazing things God does to show us love and grace every single day!

Above all, I am thankful this year for the more than seven years of ministry we have done together in God's name. I am grateful for the joy and enthusiasm y'all have for God's work in, with, and through you. I rejoice at the way y'all have emerged from the pandemic with even more vitality and certainty in God's calling for us to share the gospel with the world. I celebrate how y'all welcome my girls with open arms, how y'all keep searching for new ways to express God's love, and how y'all are so committed to the gospel work we share.
